Teacher Student Exchange Visit



The School as part of the British Council Global School Partnership initiative has had exchange visits to partner Schools in UK in the last three years. Teachers and students have visited our partner Schools in UK and in reciprocation teachers and students from the English school have visited us too. To create the International ambience in the School and facilitate our students with global knowledge and exposure, this program is going to be an annual affair.

A Teacher/Student exchange visit was again arranged this year also. Eight students under the able stewardship of Dr. BK Sahoo, the Chairman and Mr. Silpi Sahoo, Trustee, accompanied by Mrs. Rutuparna Praharaj, a Social Science teacher visited our partner school Chosen Hill School in Gloucester, UK from 7th to 17th June



2012. Each child of our school stayed in a student's home there, and to reciprocate, the same number of children from the partner School will visit our School in October 2012 and our students will host them.

The students reached on 8th of June and had a tour of London for two days and reached Oxford on 10th

June to see some of the famous colleges of the Oxford University. They received a warm welcome by their host families in the Chosen Hill School on 10th evening and stayed with them from 10th to 15th June in Gloucester and got embedded with collaborative activities



in the school and local site seeing. They had a panoramic view of the Gloucester Cathedral, the location of the famous Harry Potter films. They enjoyed the fullest in the Drayton Manor a theme park and the other places like Cirencester, Cheltenham, Chedworth Roman Villa and Dyrham Park. The SAI team experienced a wonderful tour of

the famous city of Bath, UNESCO declared World Heritage site .The group returned home after a life time experience in UK on 17th June and met up with their families at the BBSR airport after 8 exciting days abroad.
