The storytelling session was followed by craft activity and the S.O.S children made a Rainbow fish with colored papers, Fevicol and crayons. A briefing session was held by Mr. Patro of S.O.S Village where he asked the students from SAI what they expected to get out of their visit, in response they wonderfully replied "to make a change in the minds of the children we meet and entertain them."



The S.O.S Village was founded by an Austrian, Dr. Herman Gmiener and there are over 132 villages located in over 50 countries having SOS villages to help children with no parents and in need of support.
