SAI Teachers of Playgroup - Class II participated in a two day virtual workshop conducted by Churchdown Village Infant School, Gloucester, UK on January 10<sup>th</sup> and 11<sup>th</sup>. Each session was 1 ½ hours via Skype covering the topic “How to Identify Children with Special Needs”. SAI is taking steps towards inclusive educational practices and training its staff on how to identify and children with special needs while incorporating these children into the mainstream classrooms.
